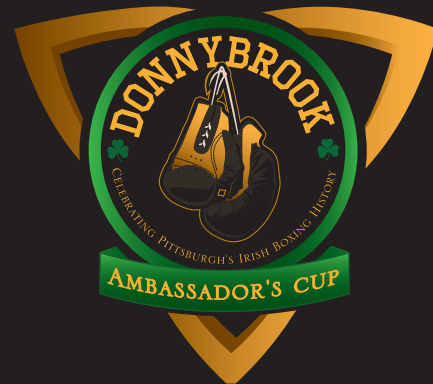
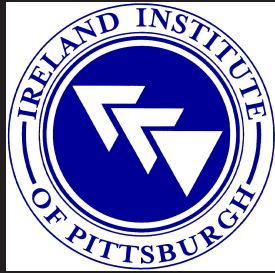

About the Donnybrook

Pittsburgh has a proud tradition of great Irish boxing. The Pittsburgh Donnybrook was first held in 2014 with Pittsburgh winning the prestigious Ambassador's Cup. Drimnagh Boxing Club returned in 2015 and 2016 winning the prize on both occasions.

Donnybrook 2023 will see Drimnagh back in Pittsburgh taking on the best of local athlete continuing the ties between our great city and Ireland.

About Drimnagh Boxing Club

Located in south Dublin city, Drimnagh Boxing Club have a proud tradition spearheaded by iconic Irish boxer Michael Carruth. Michael was the first boxer from Ireland to win an Olympic Gold Medal (Barcelona '92), and is one of only four Irish athletes to ever win an Olympic Gold Medal. Since the Olympics, Michael has volunteered as a coach in the boxing club founded by his father, legendary Irish boxing coach Austin Carruth.

Pittsburgh has invited the young boxers from the Drimnagh Boxing Club to compete each year on St. Patrick's Day on Pittsburgh's North Side. Aside from a night of great boxing, this event helps to raise revenue to give opportunities for dedicated Pittsburgh athletes to pursue their own dreams of Olympic glory.
